10th Baltic Stratigraphic Conference 12–14 September 2017 Chęciny, Poland

The Baltic Stratigraphic Association (BSA) unites Estonian, Latvian, Lithuanian and NW Russian stratigraphic commissions. Every three years the BSA organizes international conferences focused on various aspects of regional geology and stratigraphy. So far, nine meetings have taken place since 1991, in Tallinn (1991, 1996, 2008), Vilnius (1993, 2002, 2014), Riga (1999, 2011) and St. Petersburg (2005). This year, the Polish Geological Society has officially asked for membership in the BSA, which is being evaluated at the moment. On account of this procedure, we have accepted the honour to organize the 10th jubilee conference of the association.



It is our pleasure to announce that the **10th Baltic Stratigraphic Conference** will take place in the Holy Cross Mountains in Poland, in the premises of the European Centre for Geological Education (ECGE), owned by the University of Warsaw and located in the old quarry on Rzepka Hill near the historical town of Chęciny. Our meeting, held in the heart of present day Europe and geologically on the margin of the East European Craton should enhance

scientific discussions and be an opportunity for exchange of views between experienced scientists, young researchers and students. We will be very pleased to host you between September 12th and 14th 2017. Additionally, we offer the participation in pre- and/or post-conference excursions into the geology of the area.

All contributions related to geology and stratigraphy of the 'widely understood' Baltic region are most welcome. Depending on the interest and the number of participants, we will have one or two parallel sessions, a poster session, and a key-lecture on the geology of the Holy Cross Mountains. The topics of primary interest include, but are not limited to:

- Regional stratigraphic schemes, correlation and stratotypes
- Regional aspects of the international timescale
- Biostratigraphy, palaeontology and biodiversification
- Sequence stratigraphy
- Isotope stratigraphy
- Event stratigraphy
- Palaeoenvironments, palaeogeography and climates
- Crucial issues of Cambrian to Devonian geology in the Baltic area
- Geotouristic potential of the circum-Baltic countries

September 12th

Afternoon hours – arrival and registration of conference participants not taking part in the pre-conference excursion

An ice-breaker party for all participants is planned for the late evening

September 13th to 14th

Key-lecture, talks and poster sessions, workshops, committee meetings etc.

Depending on the number of declarations, the talks will be presented in one or two parallel sessions.

A special poster session is planned to take place on the first day (13th September).

There will be a possibility to spend another night at ECGE (14/15) upon earlier reservation; an additional fee will have to be paid for the meals and accommodation in this case (this does not apply to the participants of the post-conference excursion, who have it included in the excursion fee).

September 15th to 16th

Post-conference excursion 'Top geological sites in the Holy Cross Mountains'.

We will travel around by bus and come back for the night to ECGE. All meals and accommodation (2 nights 14/15 and 15/16) are included in the excursion fee. Maximum number of participants: **40** Depending on the declarations, the excursion will end at Kielce Railway Station in the evening of 16th September and/or at ECGE, where there will be a possibility to spend another night (16/17) upon earlier reservation; in this case, an additional fee will have to be paid for the meals and accommodation.

We would like to inform those travelling by car that ECGE has its own free-of-charge parking, where you will be able to leave your car during the conference.
