



## **Kazan Golovkinsky Young Scientists' Stratigraphic Meeting 2020 and Young Scientists' Summer School**

### **Sedimentary Earth Systems: Stratigraphy, Geochronology, Petroleum Resources**

June 02-06, 2020, Kazan, Russia

The sedimentary basins of the past are represented by a very broad range of facies. The evolution of these facies reflects major geographical, climatic, and biospheric changes. Professor Nikolai A. Golovkinsky (1834–1897), a founder of the Kazan geological school and the author of fundamental studies on the geology and stratigraphy of Eastern Europe, was one of the first geologists to recognize the empirical rules of sedimentary succession and the lateral diachroneity of facies in sedimentary basins (Golovkinsky-Walther's Law), which was a basis of the modern concept of sequence stratigraphy.

The Young Scientists' Summer School is aimed at teaching advanced interpretational techniques of geological, structural, stratigraphic, and geochemical analyses in shale-carbonate-evaporite petroleum basins. It is aimed at undergraduate, graduate and PhD students and early-career researchers.
